101, a resident of the Vineyard Community, Arkansas, passed away January 26, 2012 in Cane Hill, Arkansas. He was born March 3, 1910 at Artesia, New Mexico the son of Jim M. and Ella M. Acord Morris.

Jimmy's family came from West Virginia, and after a few years moved onto California. Jimmy grew up in California and found work where he could during the Great Depression. In Snowflake, Arizona, he met the love of his life, Jessie Murray. They married and lived in a converted railroad car before he brought her back to California. Jimmy found work there driving trucks, sometimes carrying high explosives. Since they had no children, Jimmy was drafted into WWII at the age of thirty-three. He served in the South Pacific theater of action on the attack transport USS Barnstable. From this ship he piloted an LCP carrying marine combat troops ashore. After the war Jimmy and Jessie joined his mother in Morrow, Arkansas, raising frying chickens. He built a two-story chicken house and a new home using the lumber cut from his property. He added more land and got into the dairy business becoming comfortably successful after lots of hard work. Jessie passed away in 1973 from cancer, causing emotional and financial strife. Jimmy eventually overcame all of this and him and his mother lived together on the farm until she passed away at the age of 102.

Jimmy left the farm and moved into a nursing home at the age of 94. After a few years there he moved into the Cane Hill Residence, where he was closer to his friends and received excellent care until his passing.
